Motion by Selectman Jordan to approve the Payroll Manifest in the amount of \$77,382.53. Seconded by Selectman Gilbert. Motion carried 4-0.

9. BUSINESS

9.1 PUBLIC WORKS ISSUES

Mr. Koch provided pictures and requested input on the damaged roof on the Highway Building. He stated that the building has extensive water damage and mold and have requested a contractor provide a quotation to repair the roof. He asked for consideration of a new location for the building, possibly at the Transfer Station. Chairman Falcone requested a warrant article be submitted for review.

Mr. Koch advised that the salt shed roof is leaking and have obtained a quotation of \$1,700.00 for a metal roof. He advised that if the Board approves it, the Highway Department will install the roof.

Mr. Koch advised that the Stump Dump is going to be on Winter Hours effective this Wednesday due to the fact that it does not have lighting. The Winter Hours at the Sump Dump are 12:00 – 4:00 on Wednesdays.

Mr. Koch advised that there will be a meeting next Monday at 7:00 PM at the Town Hall to discuss Dearborn Road intersection.

9.2 HICKORY HILL ROAD – LaRochelle

Mrs. LaRochelle, 18 Hickory Hill Road, addressed the Board in regard to a flooding situation at there property. She advised that flooding from the railroad bed and Route 101 and has impacted their new house and neighbors property. She added that the Bureau of Trails has refused to provide any assistance and was advised to present the issue to the Board. Mr. Dave Reinhold advised that they had installed a larger culvert on the road to capture the run-off from the railroad bed. He stated that previously he requested Mr. LaRochelle dig a trench to deal with the run off. He added that the Bureau of Trails has installed many culverts for the railroad beds and not sure why they refused to install one adjacent to the LaRochelle property. Town Administrator Shankle advised that it is a state problem with run off from the highway. Mr. Dennis Koch, Public Works advised that Mr. Chris Albert, Jones & Beach has inspected the area and would like to address the issue. Mr. Albert advised that he had spoken to Mr. Weeks and was advised that it has not been an issue for a number of years, and the culvert could be installed and an agreement could be addressed with DOT. He added that a plan and construction would be approximately \$5,000 to \$10,000. Town Administrator Shankle asked if this culvert was installed what other problem would be created by this installation. Mr. Albert advised that the design would not be to run off on another property. Selectman McGeough asked who from the State has refused this installation. Mr. Albert advised Mr. Barker. Selectman Gilbert asked that the situation be brought to the representatives to ask the State to correct the flooding in that area. Selectman McGeough advised that he would like to do a site inspection to review the area, and requested a actual price to correct the situation be provided to the Board. Mrs. LaRochelle advised that this issue is affecting other abutters as well. Mr. Koch advised that he would contact the representatives in regard to this issue and request Mr. Albert prov

9.3 LANDFILL CLOSURE PLAN

Mr. Koch requested approval of the Landfill Closure Plan as submitted from CMA. He advised that it was submitted by Mr. Jeff Murray, CMA and approved by the Solid Waste Committee and are requesting approval to submit it to the State. He added that the plan calls for closure in twenty five years.

Motion by Selectman Jordan to submit the Landfill Closure Plan to the State. Seconded by Selectman McGeough. Motion carried 4-0.

9.4 TRANSFER STATION TAGGING – Sophomore Class

Request to hold tagging at the Transfer Station on November 6 and November 7 was presented by the Sophomore Class at Epping High School.

Motion by Selectman McGeough to approve the request to hold a Tag Day at the Transfer Station by the Sophomore Class on November 6 & November 7, 2010. Seconded by Selectman Jordan. Motion carried 4-0.

9.5 SECOND HAND DEALERS AND PAWNBROKER ORDINANCE

Chief Greg Dodge presented another draft of the Second Hand Dealers and Pawnbroker Ordinance containing the requested changes submitted by the Board. He advised that if no additional comments are expressed the final document will be included in the packet for the next meeting.

Purchase order for Stratham Tire to install tires and snow tires on the Police Cruisers was presented for approval. Chief Dodge advised that three bids were received and requested approval of the purchase from Stratham Tire at an amount of \$1,873.44.

Motion by Selectman Jordan to approve the purchase of tires from Stratham Tire in the amount of \$1,873.44. Seconded by Selectman McGeough. Motion carried 4-0.

9.6 BUDGET UPDATE – Finance

Mrs. Lisa Fogg, Finance, advised that most of the 2011 Budget Worksheets have been received and asked when they would like to schedule the department heads to present their budgets. Chairman Falcone advised that the Board will be meeting every week with the alternate meeting weeks being dedicated to budgets. Selectman McGeough asked that department heads be given an appointment and previously a motion was made that they are required to present their budgets or they will be zeroed out.

Mrs. Fogg advised that the tax rate will be set on October 25 and asked whether the Board wanted to buy down the tax rate. She stated that the fund balance is \$1.3 Million and to buy-back a \$1.00 is \$610,000. Town

Administrator Shankle requested consideration of buying down as much as the State will allow to counteract revaluation, etc.. Selectman McGeough requested consideration of \$400,000.00.

Motion by Selectman McGeough to buy-down the 2010 Tax Rate by reducing fund balance up to \$400,000.00. Seconded by Selectman Jordan. Motion carried 4-0.

Selectman Jordan advised that problems are existing on collecting monies for services rendered and would like Finance to control the funds. Selectman McGeough requested that Mrs. Fogg assume the duty to oversee the funds in the Town's Revolving Accounts. He stated that outstanding funds have not been collected by Recreation and wanted bills to be sent out by Finance. He requested that Mrs. Fogg and Town Administrator Shankle review the procedure and advise how it will affect the workload.

Motion by Selectman Jordan to request Mrs. Fogg assume the responsibility of the Towns Revolving Funds. Seconded by Selectman McGeough. Motion carried 4-0.

9.7 RENTAL OF TOWN FACILITIES – Derry ATA

Motion by Selectman Jordan to table the request for Derry ATA. Seconded by Selectman McGeough. Motion carried 4-0.
